

Bus and Recorder Concert Information

Date: Tuesday, March 3, 2015; **Concert is at 7:00 p.m.** at TPA Auditorium at Redemption (formerly EdOptions). All 7th and 8th grade students are required to perform in this concert.

Cast call for the concert is 5:30 p.m. at TPA Auditorium at Redemption. This means that every student needs to be in the TPA Auditorium no later than 5:30 p.m. on Tuesday, March 3.

Tech rehearsal: To prepare for the concert, students will participate in a technical rehearsal that afternoon, Tuesday, March 3 between **9:30am and 12:30 p.m.** The school will provide bus transportation from TPA to TPA Auditorium and back. The permission slip below needs to be signed and returned to each student's teacher; it is required for any student to ride the bus. Attire for the tech rehearsal is normal TPA uniform.

Concert attire is required for the evening performance as specified on the course description signed by parents at the beginning of the semester and as described online on the TPA calendar. For your convenience, the required attire is explained on the back of this paper. Any family that is unable to afford the attire should confidentially contact Dr. Wolfe immediately; the school will attempt to help any family that is unable to pay for the attire. The attire for each and every student is important because it affects the overall appearance of the entire group. ***The music department welcomes donations of any black slacks your student has outgrown, so other students can use them.***
