Students who participate in Cantamus are asked to cooperate with the following policies.

Fees

The fee of \$100 per year (\$50 per semester), required for participation in Cantamus, is due by September 1.

Cancelation Policy:

The last day to cancel a student's participation and to receive a refund is September 15. **NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN FOR CANCELLATIONS** after that point.

Attendance and Part Checks

Attendance at rehearsals and performances is required. Nonattendance constitutes grounds for removal from the group without refund. A student may be restricted from participating in performances or trips or both if the student has missed rehearsals prior to the performance or trip. Singers must pass part checks, given at various times throughout the year in order to maintain membership. A student's absence may be excused only if the parent contacts the director. Email communication is preferable.

Punctuality

Singers are expected to arrive in Zelman Center at 6:55am to help set up chairs, so they can be in place ready to sing at the beginning of rehearsal at 7am. A student's tardiness may be excused only if the parent contacts the director, preferably in advance, if possible. Email communication is preferable.

Fundraising

Students who participate in Extracurricular Performing Arts (ECPA) are expected to make an effort to help raise funds for TPA's extracurricular programs, especially through the Arizona tax credit program. Other fund-raising projects can help offset the cost of trips.

Music scores and folders

Music scores and folders belong to Tempe Preparatory Academy and are loaned to student participants during the course of the semester or season. Scores and folders are to be checked in to the ECPA department assistant when the director indicates the group has completed its work with them. Students will be assessed a fee for unreturned folders or music. Occasionally, Tempe Preparatory Academy will rent scores or books for productions, for example for Opera Workshop. These items are expensive and, unfortunately, if a student loses or does not return such an item, the replacement cost and an additional fee will be passed on to the student.

AMEA regional auditions and solo and ensemble festival

Arizona Music Educators Association requires that students who wish to participate in regional choir, band, or orchestra auditions be members "in good standing" of the respective groups in their local high schools. At TPA, "good standing" means registering for and participating in the relevant extracurricular performing arts group at the time of the audition. Registration is finished after the completed form is submitted and the appropriate fees paid. Registration for solo and ensemble festival and regional auditions must be completed through the ensemble director and is due in mid-November of each year.

Parent participation

Part of the success of Cantamus each year is due to enthusiastic parent participation in fund-raising efforts and as chaperones. A Cantamus Parent Council has been active the past few years to provide direction and support for the group. The director will ask for parent help as the year progresses.
