



TPA Cantamus Disneyland Advanced Vocal Workshop

Trip Information and Itinerary

Friday, Feb 22– Sunday, Feb 24, 2013

TPA Cantamus Choir members have the opportunity to participate in the Disney Magic Music Days Advanced Vocal Workshop Feb 22 – 24, 2013. Choir members will receive a four-part vocal score to rehearse and step into an actual Disney sound studio for a recording session, complete with headphones and click track. A Disney musical director conducts the session, treating Cantamus singers like professional studio musicians hired to overdub, sight-read and bring to life a score for a Disney film.

The cost is \$210 (less discounts) and includes all Workshop costs, a Disney Workshop t-shirt, Park Hopper pass for Disneyland and California Adventure, bus transportation, breakfast at Denny's, and \$40 for lunch and dinner in the park. Additional guests, chaperones and their children are \$100 each and include the Hopper Pass and bus ride. There are no refunds. Tickets are not confirmed until this **form is completed and returned** and the Permission and Emergency Medical Release forms are signed and **returned by Monday, February 18, 2013 to the front office.**

Each student must be with at least one buddy while in the park; no student may be in the park alone. Adult chaperones are in the park for designated check-in times and emergencies but they are not assigned to any particular group. Parents pick up students at TPA on Sunday, March 25th at about 7am.

What to Bring

- A great attitude!
- **Pillow, blanket, ear plugs, eye shade** to block oncoming car lights. We all will want to sleep on the bus.
- **Change of clothes and toiletries.** Students change into their TPA shirt and freshen up (bring *and use deodorant!*) in the restaurant early Saturday morning. TPA is not responsible for lost items. Clothes, pillows and blankets can be stored on the bus. No flip flops, visible underwear or short shorts (shorts must go at least to mid-thigh). Cantamus students are to wear their **red Cantamus t-shirt** at all times while in the park.
- **Money** for the following:
 - Stops in Quartzsite, AZ. The bus has to stop there both directions. Food is available if necessary.
 - Snacks and souvenirs in the park (3 meals are provided)
 - Money for a locker at Disneyland (optional).
- **Warm sweater/ jacket/ windbreaker.** Disneyland evenings are COLD in February and there is always a chance for rain. Check weather.com for weather. Small, collapsible, **compact umbrella** is acceptable. A brimmed **hat, sunglasses and sunscreen** are advisable.
- **Cell phone** (if you have one) and **camera.** Tip: Get film or charge camera's battery before you depart. Film and/or disposable cameras are very expensive (as is everything) in the park.
- **Water bottle, protein bars, trail mix, granola bars, or snacks** for bus rides and in the park.
- **Small backpack or fanny pack** to hold water bottle, **camera, cell phone, small sunscreen, light jacket,** Park maps and snacks. Big backpacks stay on the bus or can go in a locker near the park entrance (\$).
- Please do not bring video games; iPods are permitted but may get lost, fall out of pockets, etc.
- Disneyland opens at 8am and rides close at midnight. California Adventure hours are 10am-9pm. Check out ridemax.com if you want to plan your ride strategy in advance.
